#### **About the NDRP**



The National Disability Research Partnership gives money for **research**.

We will say **NDRP** for short.



**Research** means to look into something to find out more about it.



The NDRP gives money for research about disability.



The research must be

• Done by people with disability

or

• Together with people with disability.



We want more research about

- How people with disability live their lives
- The things that are important to people with disability
- What is hard for people with disability
- · What helps people with disability.



We know that all people with disability are different from each other.




We want to make sure research shows all the different ideas people with disability have.

### The NDRP principles



The NDRP put together 4 good ideas that help us to do our work well.



We call these ideas our **principles**.



The 4 principles are

- 1. Do more good research about important issues for people with disability
- 2. Make sure people with disability are part of the research team
- 3. Support researchers to do better research about disability
- 4. Share what we find out from research.


# 1. Do more good research about important issues for people with disability



We want more research about disability.



The research will help us with how we do things to do with disability in Australia.



It will also help us understand what we can do better.



We will try to get more people to do research together with people with disability.



We will make sure we give money to do research about things that are very important.

## 2. Make sure people with disability are part of the research team



We want to make sure many different people are part of research teams.



We want to support research that lets people with disability make the decisions.



We want to learn from

- · Many different people with disabilities
- · Community organisations.



**Community organisations** are groups that work to make things better for people.



We also want to learn from people with disability that are not often part of research.



We will make sure people with disability get fair pay for their research work.

# 3. Support researchers to do better research about disability



We want to bring people that do disability research together.



We want them to support each other and work together.



We want to have more jobs for people with disability that do research.



We want to make sure Australia does more disability research and gets better at it.



We want to work with the community so that they can do more research.



We also want to teach the community how to use the things that research finds out.



This could be to make things better for everyone in the community.

#### 4. Share what we find out from research



We will share what we find out from research with people with disability and the community.



We will share what we find out in many different ways.
